THE CLIFTON PARK-HALFMOON PUBLIC LIBRARY INVITES THE COMMUNITY TO HELP PLAN THE FUTURE OF THE LIBRARY

Clifton Park, NY- The Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library is embarking upon a strategic planning process to explore and develop a roadmap for the future of the Library. The first step in this process will be a series of interactive planning workshops that will be open to the public.

“The goal is to learn how the Library might best collaborate with the community to create the most vibrant future for us all,” says Library Director Alexandra Gutelius. “The knowledge and ideas of community members is key to the strategic planning process and how the Library will continue to best serve our patrons.”

The community is invited to attend one of three workshops that will be offered and have an opportunity to contribute their ideas. Attendees will be asked to share their knowledge of how major social and technological change is impacting our community; offer ideas for new or expanded projects and programs that could better support the community; assess what the Library should continue to offer and what we can do differently to ensure continued success; and suggest services and facilities that could be integrated into the current facility for improved convenience.
