
As the Assemblyman representing the Town of Halfmoon in the 112th District, I am writing in regards to Permit #4-0126-0033-00001 which entails the expansion of the Colonie Town Landfill. This request to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) calls for not only expanding the size of this landfill, but also for an additional 20+ years of operation.

Although residents of the Town of Halfmoon have attended information meetings and additionally have had a chance to weigh in during public comment periods, the size and scope of the elevations of the final contours are extremely difficult to envision.

To that end, I am echoing the sentiments of Halfmoon Town Supervisor Kevin Tollison and his proposal to place large weather balloons around the site that match the elevations of the final build contours. Such a marker will not only provide the residents of the Town of Halfmoon an accurate visual impact, but also to those nearby neighbors in the Town of Colonie.

Thank you in advance for your consideration to provide these communities a clear vision of what the result of this proposed project could ultimately look like upon completion.
