They find that many motorist do exceed the posted limit, they recommend enforcement of the existing speed limit rather than reduction of the posted speed limit.
- 5. Received from NYS Dept. of Transportation, their results of the speed study reduction for Route 9 between the 40 MPH speed zone north of Route 146 and Kinns Road. Based on the radar data and accident history, they have determined that a reduction of the existing speed limit is not warranted at tis time.
- 6. Received from NYS Dept. of Transportation, their results of the speed study reduction for Anthony Road between Farm to Market Road and Vosburgh Road, 40 MPH. It was determined that after taking radar measurements, that a speed reduction is not warranted at this time, however they recommend enforcement of the existing speed limit.
