Section 56-6 Restrictions: The owner of the dog shall be responsible when a dog violates any restrictions contained herein. It shall be unlawful for any dog in the Town of Halfmoon to:

- (a) Be at large.
- (b) Engage in loud howling or barking so as to habitually or regularly annoy, alarm or bother any person; barking at an intrusion or disturbance shall not constitute a violation of this article. It shall be a violation of this section for a dog to continuously bark for more than 15 minutes.
- (c) Cause damage or destruction to property or commit a nuisance by habitually defecating or urinating on public property or on premises of a person other than the owner of such dog unless the owner of said premises has given permission, or scavenging through refuse upon the premises of a person other than the owner of such dog, unless the owner of said premises has given permission therefor. Any waste left by a dog shall be collected and properly disposed of when the waste is left on property not owned by the owner of the dog. Any failure to collect and properly dispose of the waste shall constitute a violation of this section.
- (d) Commit an overt act which causes a person, who is peaceably conducting himself in any place where he may lawfully be, to be placed in reasonable apprehension of bodily harm, when the dog has the apparent ability to inflict such harm.
- (e) Habitually chase or run alongside of motor vehicles or bicycles.
