Corporal James A. Buck, Civil War lived all his life in Halfmoon with his wife and children. He fought in the Civil War under Captain Lucius E. Wilson. James served in Company D. 22<sup>nd</sup> Regiment of New York State. He enrolled on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April 1861 and mustered out in Albany on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June 1863.

After the war James attended many Civil War reunions where he received a ribbon at each reunion. He received his last ribbon in 1907. He is buried in the Union Cemetery, Halfmoon where his grave is marked with a GAR star.
