Specialist 5 (SP5) John Peter Miller honorably served our nation during the Vietnam War in the United States Army 3rd Infantry Regiment (The Old Guard) from 1968-1971. John was born on November 13, 1946 and raised in Poughkeepsie, New York. After graduating from Poughkeepsie High School and the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA, he enlisted in the United States Army in 1968 and reported to basic training at Fort Dix, New Jersey. He was stationed at Fort Myer in Washington, DC for the duration of his service. Upon his honorable discharge from the military he attended and graduated from Boston College Law School and went on to practice law for 35 years. In the mid-1980's John moved his family to the Clifton Park area, where he resided for his remaining years. He was a devoted family man, an avid golfer, fisherman, and boater.

He is survived by his wife of 48 years Linda, two sons, two daughters, two daughters-in-law, and four grandchildren. John passed away on October 3, 2020 and was buried with military honors in St. Peter's Cemetery, Poughkeepsie, New York.
