

Rex Stuart Wood United States Army 1974 –1977



Rex was a resident of the Town of Halfmoon with his wife, Christine, for over 20 years. He was the father of 4 children, Michele Barron (Jim), April Brustle (Kevin), Nicholas Wood (ex-wife Stacy) and Jeremy Wood (Sarah); and 2 step-children, Marissa Hebert and Michael Palermo (April). He also had 14 grandchildren.

Rex was born in New London, Conn., on December 6, 1953. He later moved to New York and graduated from Willsboro HS in 1971, and attended North Country Community College. He proudly served his country in the US Army from 1974-1977 with the Military Police as a gunman aboard the Presidential helicopter. He was honorably discharged and received the Presidential Service Badge and Good Conduct Medal. He worked at the Stratton VAMC in Albany, NY from 1978-2009. He retired as a Criminal Investigator. He also worked part-time for the Mechanicville, NY Police department for 20 years. Rex passed from this earth on January 19, 2023 and is buried at the Gerald B.H. Solomon Saratoga National Cemetery.
