Received from the Town Planning Board resolutions approved at the March 27, 2017 meeting: Change of Use/Tenant Applications for Architectural Glass & Meta, 3 Liebich Lane and for Merrill Lynch, 453 Route 146 (Parkford Square 2); Regarding Final Approval of Phase V of the Glen Meadows PDD, Upper Newtown Road; Approval of the Lot D Improvements, 5 Rexford Way; Site Plan Approval of the Paris Site Plan, 556 Hudson River Road.

Received from the NYS Department of Transportation a response to the letter the Town of Halfmoon submitted on March 16, 2017 requesting a traffic signal study be conducted at the intersection of Route 9 and Kinns Road. The letter states that an engineer visited the intersection in June 2014 and observed both the operation of the traffic signal and the flow of vehicles through the intersection. It was noted that some vehicles did have to wait for two cycles to clear the intersection and the timing plan for the traffic signal was modified. NYSDOT agrees that the provision of additional turn lanes on the side road approaches may be a long-term solution, however current funding is focused on preserving the condition of the existing state highway and bridge assets. The Department does not feel a turn arrow is warranted at this time.
- **9. Received** from the Saratoga County Department of Public Works notification that they will be resurfacing County Road 86, Upper Newtown Road, from NYS 146 to US 4 & NYS 32 during the spring of 2017.
- 10. Received from NYS Department of Environmental Conservation stating that they concur with the Town of Halfmoon's recommendation that the Town Board be SEQR Lead Agency for the Mott Orchard PDD project.
- 11. Received from the Association of Towns a letter to the Supervisor outlining a plan put forward by Governor Cuomo establishing a countywide shared services property tax savings plan as part of the state's 2017-18 Budget.
