Resolution** that the Town Board authorizes the Supervisor to enter into a one year fire sprinkler inspection contract for 2019 with SRI Fire Sprinkler, LLC. for the fire sprinkler inspections at the Town Hall Building, Highway Department, Water Treatment Facility, Park Maintenance Building, Town Park Clubhouse for a total amount of \$2,025.00 and authorizes the Supervisor to execute the agreement, subject to the review and approval of the Town Attorney.
