#### Overall Program Goals:

To assist those individuals who are living in or seeking long-term recovery from the disease of addiction, as well as their families and loved ones through recovery resources and recovery supports, while working to extinguish the stigma of addiction through understanding and knowledge.

To provide the connections between the religious community and the professional recovery community to advance and fulfill the statement by Isaiah and the Lord:

to bring good news to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to let the oppressed go free,

## Objectives:

- 1. To provide a safe environment for people desiring recovery, enabling them to make connections to the services they may require. We provide engagement in fellowship in a supportive manner and environment. This includes hosting meetings for several recovery groups, including Narcotics Anonymous (NA), Alcoholics Anonymous (AA), Nar-Anon (for families/friends having a loved-one with the disease of addiction to drugs and other substances) and Al-Anon (for families/friends having a loved-one with the disease of addiction to alcohol).
- 2. To provide a place (location) to call or stop in to connect with the "web" of contacts, acting as a hub to connect individuals with the support/services they seek.
- 3. To facilitate opportunities and develop a working relationship with the religious community, social and health care professionals, treatment providers, and partnering organizations to create approaches that meet the needs of the recovery community.
