February 22nd, 1870: To the Supervisor of the
Town of Halfmoon from the Commissioners of
Highways, listing the improvements needed.

• New Bridge at Gallett's Mills	\$1000
• Repairing new Bridge near Gideon Close	\$75
• New Bridge at Callanhan's	\$150
• One Bridge at Chriddenden's	\$200
• One Bridge at VanDenBerg Lansing's	<u>\$50</u>
Total	\$1475.00

To the Supervisor of the Town of
Half Moon in the County of Saratoga!

The Commissioners of Highways of
said town do hereby report that the following
improvements are necessary to be made
on their roads and bridges in the said town
to wit: one new bridge at Gallett's Mills
estimated to cost \$1000, repairing new bridge
near Gideon Close estimated to cost \$75,
a new bridge at Callanhan's estimated
to cost \$150, one bridge at Christenden's
\$200, one bridge at Van Derbrug Lansing's
estimated at \$50, ; That the total expense
of making such improvement is by us
estimated at \$1475.00
