**Commissioners of Highways,**

**Town of Halfmoon**

**February 28<sup>th</sup>, 1871 Petition with 35 signatures**

**Description of Private or Separate Road running  
through and across the lands of Moses Clements  
in the Town of Halfmoon**

Description of Strate or Separate Tract  
running through and across the lands  
of Moses Clements in the town of  
Walden.

Beginning at the highway about fifteen  
miles south of Walden Clements see  
evidence on Road District No 14 in the  
town of Walden, running south  
52<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>° east about forty four rods, thence  
following said road as it is now tracked  
and bounded to the house of Moses Clements  
one hundred & fifteen rods - thence fol-  
lowing said road to the highway on  
Road District No 10, being at a point  
about ten rods east of Sucker Crack Bridge  
and being North from the Residence  
of Samuel B. Howland. Eight one rod  
making a total distance of 240 rods  
or three fourth of a mile, running a course  
about South east.

Dated Walden Nov 28<sup>th</sup> 1871.
