Specialist (SP5) William Francis Lamoutte, known by friends and family as “Billy”, served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from 1967-1970 as part of Company D 197th Support Battalion and 197th Infantry Brigade. He was decorated with the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars, the Vietnam Campaign Medal, Sharpshooter (M-14 and M-16), the Army Commendation Medal and Good Conduct Medal. He married Maureen Magee Lamoutte in 1970 after an honorable discharge and raised his son, Keith, and daughters, Tara and Christine, in Brooklyn, NY. He worked on Wall Street before starting his own home improvement and remodeling business in 1989. He is fondly remembered for his mischievous sense of humor, loving nature and ability to make friends everywhere he went. William is survived by his wife, 3 children and 7 grandchildren.
