## **Town of Halfmoon**

**Bond of Superintendent: Nov 6th, 1854**

**Bond of the Supervisor: March 8<sup>th</sup>, 1855  
and March 7<sup>th</sup>, 1873**

Now all men by these presents, that are  
John Capsey, Stephen Emigh and Stephen B  
Gosline

of the town of 'Hag Moor, in the County of Saratoga,  
are held and firmly bound to Benjamin  
Wright-Eg; Supervisor of said town, in the penal-  
sum of one thousand nine hundred and fifty-  
one <sup>and</sup> dollars, to be paid to the said Benjamin  
Wright-Eg, or his successor in office; to the  
which payment well and truly to be made  
we bind ourselves and our legal representatives  
jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.  
Witness our hands and seals this thirtieth day  
of October 1854.

Whereas, the said John Capsey  
has been duly elected Town Superintendent of Common  
schools for the said town of 'Hag Moor; And therefore,  
the conditions of this obligation is such, that if the said  
John Capsey shall faithfully apply and legally disburse  
all the school money which may come into his hands  
during his term of office, as such Town School trustee  
and faithfully discharge all the duties of said office;  
then this obligation to be null and void; otherwise  
to remain in full force and virtue —

BOND OF SUPERVISOR.

(Chapter 721 Laws of 1868.)

Know all men by these presents, That we Daniel R White  
Charles H Clute and Henry J Dunbach  
of the town of Halfmoon county of Saratoga and State of New York, are  
held and firmly bound unto Jacob C Furst Town Clerk of said town,  
in the penal sum of (\$ 4000 ) Four thousand dollars, to be paid to the said Town  
Clerk or to his successor in office. For which payment well and truly to be made, we bind our-  
selves, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these pres-  
ents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1879

Whereas, The above bounden Daniel R White  
was, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March 1879, duly elected Supervisor of the town  
of Halfmoon, in the county of Saratoga :

Now, therefore, the condition of this Bond is such, that if the said Daniel R  
White shall faithfully discharge his duties as such Supervisor, and shall well  
and truly keep and pay over and account for all moneys belonging to his town, to his successor  
in office, and convey into his hands, as such Supervisor, without fraud or delay, then this obliga-  
tion to be void, otherwise to be in full force and virtue.
