To Trustees and Boards of Education:

Under the provisions of the Education Law, contracts for instruction are not effective until approved by the Commissioner of Education. In order that such contracts may be approved, blanks must be completely filled out. The contracts when executed should be delivered to the district superintendent of the supervisory district in which the school district is located. Such district superintendent will forward such contracts to the Department, with his approval or disapproval endorsed thereon. Contracts covering the complete school year should be filed with the Rural Education Bureau of the Education Department by October 15th.

THIS AGREEMENT

and Board of Education, Union Free School

Witnesseth, That whereas said party of the first part has been duly empowered by a vote of a majority of the qualified voters of said school district no. 7, to enter into a contract with the said party of the second part as trustee of said school district no. 9 whereby all the children of school age residing in said school district no. 7 shall be entitled to be taught in said school district no. 9 for a period of 190<sup>1</sup> days in the school year commencing August 1, 1930, pursuant to the provisions of article 21 (580-86) of the Education Law and acts amendatory thereof;

Now, therefore, The said party of the first part hereby agrees to pay to the party of the second part the sum of \$ 25 per year per pupil  
for receiving into and teaching in the public  
school in district no. 9 town of Malta, during the term of this

contract, all children of school age residing in school district no. 7 town of Halfmoon; such sum to be paid as follows semi-annually and the said party of the second part hereby agrees that in consideration of the payment of such sums as hereinbefore provided all the children of school age residing in said school district no. 7 town of Halfmoon shall be admitted into the public school in said district no. 9 town of Malta, and be taught therein during the term of this contract; and such children shall be entitled to, and shall receive, like and equal instruction to that imparted to the children of like ages, grades and departments and shall be accorded all the rights and privileges enjoyed by the resident children of said school district no. 9 in attendance at the school therein.

Trustees can not legally apportion among the parents of pupils attending school under contract, as compensation for the transportation of their children, any balance of state money which may remain after paying the tuition of such pupils. Such balance may be used to pay for the transportation of children when such children have been provided with transportation under a bona fide contract. Trustees who violate this law become personally liable.

Section 285 of the Education Law provides that no trustee shall be personally interested directly or indirectly in any contract which he makes in behalf of the district.
